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Subject National Marine Sanctuary Priorities Kauai- Give them a Break they have to teach their children

Includes a few species (not all known added), Access, Issues, Trash, Overfishing, Cultural help and barrier, Educating and implementing laws.

I have been a 30 year resider, and traveler, activist implementing ideas and continuing a tradition in a hard corners of which I can break. Give this community a chance, and understand there will be a transitional change to "modern" and post modern ideas... in their language.

### Beach Public Access

Needs of trucks to drive along side the beach help mothers, and elders or campers carry things. Yosemite National and other parks were able to control this use, yet let the public access. Certain times of the month and year (daily and seasonal) should be sanctified. There is certain times of birthing nights and morning that animals aren't allowed to be hunted, the unwritten rule still apply to some....those who don't follow help with the decline and over fish.

Before we needed to get the message across for land and take their trash. Don't sleep along the waters edge, your trash and belongs must be secured to your truck or tent. This applies to driving.

Health and Weight-Overweight will continue and health issues will rise if men reside on land more. It will lead the men to consume on land, needs to find other ways for activities where there is no work or space or land use. These men and women are great watermen and know it like the back of their hand. Hawaii means the breathe of water or to Eve. As in Atom and Eve.

Mainland, or outsourced employer benefits financially and long time local residers. Mainland Retirees make it hard for hard willing and educated youth professionals who come off from apprenticeship.

Count and weigh -ins contest help enforce laws on other fish. Most men know that there is hardly any other species and don't catch or release those of small size or rarity.

Language- Culturalism –Fish Freeway

Trash-

Educate to the community to bring their own bas for trash. "Locals" and locals who reside

here to help clean even if it is not there trash. It will pay off on who really is caring for the land. Hotels and Private communities also have to care for their residents and run-off. Even if one can afford to pay, they must also watch for their extensive habits.

Dog poop like human poop.

Saves the time in finding

Public needs to take more care in-hooks, weight, lines, broken slippers, cups, straws, chips. Save Sanctuary or areas: it is remarkably clean that little amounts of trash stand out. I have taken runs, or beach drives with my grandfather with Personal trash bags to fill along the way. There is a shortage of cans, plastics, lighters, nails, and bottles on the beach for recycle in the last 30 years.

Save the County with finance and labor by supporting us with our Hawaiian charter programs. It is our Heritage to teach our children this kapu system aka environmental sustainable balance. Again, the death penalty was abused by religious superiority of Christians. There were less death penalties during Kamehameha I, for people found refuge like rehabilitation centers or island. The kapu is to insure the low inventory of stones, elements, space, fish, plant, bird, marsh, forest. Etc. Mana, Kapule, Alekoko of Kaua'i is a great example and one of my projects I am working on.

Recycle, paper/form. Plastic and plastic toys, bottles, foam, food, separations should be implemented

Landfill Breakdown seeps into soil and sand, filter mollusks, sand crabs, sea urchins, polps. Excessive trash can cut the time in run off from other things buried in the heap.

Help maintain trash levels as well.

Analyze consumption, which is less than Oahu.

In hopes of rebuilding traditional fishpond walls that help natural procreation and farming, or coral reef growth with layout of old iron piping for the plantation and hurricane is a great use (tied down coral with wire that will rust back into red dirt.)

Community –employment. DLNR. “Game Wardens”

Not be so lenient on those who don't abide measurement, age or weight rule.

Community is helpful in notifying DLNR on turtle, fish, and scallop poaching and naming whom.

Holoholo, Andys, Blue Dolphin Charters help educating tourists. They should work with Schools. Should collaborate with schools with field trips, public schools should put more effort in liability if they want their children's grades higher. It's the attitude and opportunity to make use of visual information and hands on habits to care for the environment or species.

Class of 97 one of the last public school educated children that had this opportunity. To be able to do so other than charter or private school. The majority of students are bilingual and multicultural, the previous kapu system (belief system- is a management of economical sustainable organic resourcing). The death penalty was meant for the control of human overgrowth if life wasn't be considered by humankind, but this only amongst Hawaiians and not foreigners who did most of the consuming without supporting procreation of other

transitioning elements or moving organics. Apprentice started at age 6, and visual communication and memory before age 1.

## Dead zone

Fertilizer and invasive overgrowth needs to be resolved. Certain areas are due to plantation bleaching, fertilizing, and reef choking. –Waimea, Hanapepe, Lihue, Waipouli, Kanioloa, Koloa Poipu, “Waiohai”, “Sheratons”, “Alertons”, Pakala, Kekaha “Keyhole”, “Secrets”, Second Ditch Beach. You will see a ridiculous change in kuleana (economic responsibility)

Kekaha decline in algal colony due to low tide zone exposed during extremely low tides. Limu and algae overgrowth have choked reefs of these areas. Pakalas/Makaweli have been profound of limu nutrified overgrowth that blankets the reef, urchin barren, holdfast are pulled easily on a 3-foot swell. Not to add the extreme weather change in the past years. We are having the same weather as the 1940's as quoted from elders, and old visitors I have spoken to. Sunscreen has made waters murky and unlivable for weaker sea life and endemic sea life. Thankful, most locals don't take so much aluminum, zinc and perfume; tourist wakes up later than 9am and leave by sunset to clear the waters. They still walk along reef at the wrong times of the day or areas. Kipu to Prince Kuhio has been shorting in fish ranges and species.” Zeros or Inters” winter water current rises and shift water north with the wrap-around of northwest equilateral current along the coast of the current break wall. Instead of the break wall, the highway should have been depleted and the use of Kekaha road as the main road. This excess rise of water notifies me that the reef has slowed in growth and not to forget the Kukuiola harbor engineered wall. This boulder issue also has made an impact for the Nawiliwili and Kalapaki harbor. So although, the Japanese nets don't arrive in baby whale size lumps, and cans or plastic afloat along my daily walks anymore my elders and I still see so much drastic change. Hawaii locals who have lived here within generations in are first come first serve when it comes to providing answers for the last 80 years (4 generations in not including generation x and y.)

This process has caused a slow coral reef growth, low growth of sharks, extinction of certain animals such as opihi (limpets), 'olepa (sunrise shells/ pecten), Pupu and puka shells (pagarus), oyster and mollusks, and ect ect. Celebrations and abuse of procreation for the creatures have also helped in the decline. Again more wardens who know the waters, local longtime fishermen should be voted into a board or council of leading men to control the boat harbors. A decline ahead of 1990's can't be read when divers and jewelers pick up shells. Especially divers who pull empty shells from trenches. The live pecten hide amongst other empty shells as well, where the he'e (octopus), crabs and starfish have to search.

Fines and licensing like hunting on land should be made. As foreigners come in they make large amounts of money and traditional fishing locals scrounge for left over and for live food as most don't shop at those jewelry stores they don't know what asking price really are. Meaning they end up helping the buyers and divers, without knowing what they are really

doing. They are paid under the table at \$7-10. Being more aware and speaking in Hawaiian Pidgin, have been more careful in telling or opening up to anyone...someday due to my language change (back in forth in American English and British Hawaiian pidgin.)

Excrement Waste- schedule days for their dumping.

Byron Australia fines, for not separating recycle rubbish and compose or non-color paper. Over fishing in Micronesia has made monk seals migrate to Hawaii.

Baja's excessive fishing on deep sea has au-ma-kua (beings-like-me) squids, whales; sharks come up for their own inquiry of humans.

Traditional fishing and systems (programs) of Eastern islands are a good resource of controlling over fishing. In Hawaii, contest and weigh-ins help maintain a great level of understanding for those not fishermen.

Ekahakumoana or antipathidae black coral has made \$25 million in sales by 2007. Foreigners have been paying Niihauans \$7-20 a necklace and selling them for \$1010 in their stores, discussing local passer buyers. This is a 50-year growth span, if my grandparent says so.

VISA for Immigrating Americans and other international visitors should have a stricter visa and surveillance as their "opportunity" for visitation is to own and not work, causing an influx of human consumption and over population for eco -sustainable areas. This also can cut down on slavery, low standard labor, cultural imposing with "unwritten laws" of eco management that had already been implemented in the Hawai'ian-Kaua'i-Ni'ihau indigenous and native culture. 2 year probations to receive state licensing marriage, SNAP could detour the counter culture abuse; also notifying youth of the intent that has also been happening elsewhere.

I have researched Kauai and observed for the last 27 years. Researched the Hawaiian 8 residential island to humanity for 7 years. The last 3 years of my life educating California Students, Producers, Directors and City dwellers. Two years of my life not included was hospitalization in Los Angeles. There is more that is not added to this list, but this is all for today as you wanted comments not stories on how land was maintained in this particular enviroment.
